**Tuesday October 11 2022** Conversation at the Crocker at 7pm: *The Future of History in Sarasota County* - Dr. Josh Goodman, Manager of Sarasota County's Division of Historical Resources.

**Tuesday November 8 2022:** Conversation at the Crocker at 7pm. *The Crocker Memorial Church: Past, Present and Future.* Board Member and professional archivist and historian Deborah Walk has been researching the lost years of the Crocker Church, the Crocker family, and Sarasota life during the time of the Crockers. Her presentation highlights the past but also talks about the church's name changes and geographical migrations which ended in 2006 at Pioneer Park. With conservation construction underway, Deborah also talks about the future of this adaptive reuse building curated by the Historical Society.

Conversations at the Crocker is a series of in-person interactive panel discussions on events that shaped Sarasota County's past and continue to exert influence on its present and probably the future. We start at 7pm in the Crocker Memorial Church. Reservations not necessary. FREE to Historical Society members; \$10 at the door for yet-to-bemembers.
